

This category recognises excellence of either personal academic achievement or admirable individual contribution to the education of others while incorporating multiculturalism as a core value and practice in the area of curriculum and/or educational environment and culture.

Academic/ Education

Community

This category recognises individual contributions that benefit the community or volunteer organisations that have improved the lives of the people of the Sunshine Coast culturally and linguistically.

This category aims to highlight personal achievement and contribution in the local business community or in the wider region of any kind in pursuing employment practices that value employee languages, cultures and ethnicities and using its diverse workforce to create and/or harness business opportunities.

Sport

This category is for any sport and for players, coaches, referees or other people that show promise in their field and thus enhance the wider -community with their knowledge and excellence.

This category covers numerous areas such as music, design, theatre, dance and all other creative arts that show outstanding communal enlightening in regards to their own cultural background.

Arts

Youth Achievement


The Youth Achievement award is created for people under the age of 18 that show promise in any of the six categories above.

This category was designed to draw attention to people who have made advancements in the area, achieved exceptional tasks in the field or performed their jobs in an excellent manner.
