Queensland Department of Communities, Multi-cultural Affairs Queensland & Commonwealth Department of Family, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs.

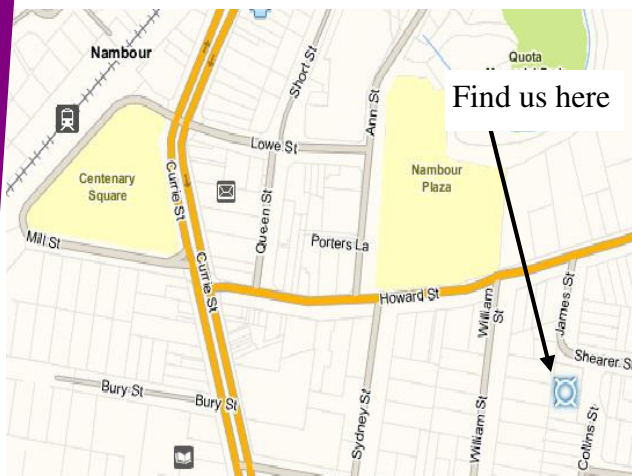


Our Story
