- Disability access and designated parking spaces
- 5 separate meeting rooms, ranging from small 'interview' size to large room that hosts 80 people. All rooms feature cooling, heating, insect screens & ceiling fans
- Tables: 14 rectangular (each table seats six) Chairs: 100
- Semi commercial kitchen, includes crockery, cutlery, urns cooking equipment, dishwasher, two ovens, fridge, microwave
- Parking on site for 20 vehicles plus plenty of street parking
- Public transport: bus depot 8 min walk, town centre 4 mins
- Recreation: playground and large undercover open area
- Wi Fi available to room renters
